The 2013 Crime totals for Fort Worth will be published in the news soon. You will be pleasantly surprised that even though the population has soared in Fort Worth, the crime in North Fort Worth is relatively low, some of the lowest numbers in the city! The FWPD will tell you the numbers are low because of the Code Blue Citizens On Patrol Program. The Villages of Woodland Springs is one of the largest neighborhoods in North Fort Worth and one of the safest. We want to keep it that way. We have a great group of volunteers, but we can't be out there 24/7. We need more volunteers that can help us out, even if it's an hour or two a month.

The Citizens On Patrol work directly with the FWPD. We carry police radios and report real crime as we see it. We can patrol by car, foot or bike and if you would prefer not to patrol, we have training for radio operators, who monitor our calls right from the comfort of their homes. Breakfast with Santa - Cold day of fun!!







Woodland Springs Homeowner's Association
