### COVENANTS CORNER

Spring is upon us again. It's now time to start looking at your yard and the exterior of your home. Did you know that the documents not only apply to the grass in your yard but also the trees, bushes, and the exterior of your home? Is it time to trim my bushes? Are those weeds in my yard and flowerbed? Maybe it's time for me to trim my trees so light can reach my lawn. Is that a dead tree in my yard? Maybe I need to get that replaced before it gets too hot. Also remember to do regular maintenance checks to the exterior of your home. Is it time to paint? Do those shutters, garage doors or front doors need new stain? These are just a few of the things you need to be thinking about at this time. If you are going to change the color of any portion of the exterior of your home, you will need to get ACC approval prior to any work beginning.

Here's what the CC&R's have to say about yard maintenance and house maintenance.

5.2.8 Rear Yard Maintenance. The Owners and occupants of any Lots at the intersections of streets or adjacent to parks, playgrounds or other facilities, and any other Lots, where the rear yard is visible to public view must maintain the rear yard so as not to be unsightly when viewed from the streets, adjacent parks, playgrounds,

neighboring Lots, or other facilities. The ACC is the arbitrator of acceptable appearance standards.

- 5.3.1 House Maintenance. Each owner, at the owner's expense, must maintain all improvements on the lot. Maintenance includes preventative maintenance and repairs as needed. Each owner is expected to maintain his lot's improvements at a level, to a standard, and with an appearance that is commensurate with the neighborhood. Specifically, each owner must repair and/or replace worn, rotten, deteriorated, and unattractive materials, and must regularly repaint all painted surfaces.
- 5.3.3 Yard Maintenance. Each owner/resident, at their own expense, must maintain the yards on his lot with an appearance that is commensurate with the existing standards of the neighborhood. Specifically, each owner must:
- a. Maintain an attractive ground cover of grass or sod on all yards visible from a street. Xeriscape or ground cover other than grass or sod shall be permitted with prior ACC approval.
- b. Maintain a minimum of one (1) tree in the front yard. The following trees have been approved for installation. (Alternate types of trees submitted to the Architectural Rules Committee

will be considered for approval.)

- 1. Ash, Texas
- 2. Elm, Cedar
- 3. Cedar, Eastern Red
- 4. Cypress, Bald
- 5. Magnolia, Bay
- 6. Maple, Caddo
- 7. Oak, Bur
- 8. Oak, Evergreen
- 9. Oak, Southern Red
- 10. Pear, Aristocrat
- 11. Pear, Bradford
- 12. Pear, Callery
- 13. Pecan, Native
- 14. Pine, Austrian
- 15. Plum, Mexican
- 16. Walnut, Black
- c. Maintain in good working condition all lawn irrigation systems.
- d. Edge the street curbs, sidewalks and driveways at regular intervals.
- e. Mow the lawns and grounds at regular intervals.
- f . Prevent lawn weeds or grass from exceeding 6 inches in height.
- g. Not plant vegetable gardens that are visible from a street.







## 2014 Pool Season Information

Can you believe it's almost pool season again? I don't know about you but I am ready! This has been a long cold winter!

The 2014 Pool Season will begin on May 3rd and run through September 28th.

The Villages of Woodland Springs features many community amenities, including six swimming pool locations for resident use. In addition to the map of the pool locations provided, here is some general information regarding the 2014 Pool Season:

The community pools are open Sunday thru Thursday 10am – 9pm and Friday / Saturday 10am – 10pm (As a reminder, Pool Maintenance days will be on Mondays and Tuesdays of each week).

The Slide Pool schedule for 2014 will be:

May 23rd - May 26th (Memorial

Day Weekend) May 30th – June 1st

June 6th – August 24th Daily (Closed on Tuesdays for Maintenance)

August 29th – September 1st (Labor Day Weekend)

All other pool locations will be open:

May 3rd – September 28th Daily (Pool Maintenance days performed Mondays and Tuesdays)

2014 Pool Maintenance Days - In effort to provide the cleanest, healthiest pool experience possible to our residents throughout the duration of the pool season, there will be a daily closure of each pool once a week for maintenance purposes. Each Monday and Tuesday, three of the six community pools will be closed for treatment and maintenance by the First Service Residential onsite facilities staff. The closures are as follows:

Closed Mondays – Timberland Amenity Center Pool, Bray Birch Pool, and Wild Pear Pool

Closed Tuesdays – Slide Pool (Woodland Springs), Old Denton Pool, and Angel Food Pool

Valid pool access cards are required at all community pool locations. If you already have a pool access card, it will work at all pool gates and restrooms for the 2014 pool season. If you would like to acquire a new pool access card, please visit the onsite management office at 12209 Timberland Blvd. Replacement and additional access cards are available to residents at a cost of \$25 for each card. If you rent your home within the VOWS community and wish to acquire a pool access card, you must present a completed Tenant Authorization Form. The forms may be obtained at the onsite management

All residents MUST utilize their

pool access cards to access the pools and restroom facilities. Please do not open the gates for patrons without a valid access card and please do not ask other residents to let you into the pool areas. As in past years, pool security monitors will be checking with each pool patron to ensure that their pool access card is active. Inactive or invalid pool access cards may remain with security. These cards will be provided to the First Service Residential onsite management office on a daily basis.

Reminder to follow Pool Rules – Please ensure that all persons utilizing the pools strictly adhere to the posted pool rules. Pool rules are posted at each of the pool locations and on the community website (www.woodlandspringshoa.com). All residents and their accompanied guests are responsible for knowing and adhering to these rules. The rules have been established for the general safety and enjoyment of everyone using the pool facilities. In





## **Code Blue Connection**



Office Barry Sawyer asked that the Code Blue Connection article be about being a responsible pet owner in the City of Fort Worth. There are many ordinances that the pet owner must abide by if you own or harbor a cat, dog or ferret.

- The City defines a pet owner as anyone who harbors an animal for three or more consecutive days. If you are in violation of these ordinances you can be charged with a Class C misdemeanor.
- The above mentioned animals must be licensed by four months of age after it has been vaccinated for rabies and the license must be renewed annually or triennially depending on the microchip status and vaccination schedule of the animal.
- When a dog is being walked or with its owner off its property, the dog must be on a leash and accompanied by the owner at all times. It the dog is without a leash or not accompanied by the owner, it is considered unrestrained and is in violation of the restraint ordinance.
- You must properly care for your pet with nutrition/water and protect your pet from the elements at all times.
- No person shall discharge, deposit or allow to accumulate on private or public property in the City of Fort Worth, any animal waste. Violators can be charged with a Class C misdemeanor.
- It is a violation to keep any animal or bird that causes frequent or long-continued noise that disturbs the comfort and repose of any person in the immediate vicinity. This is one of the most frequent calls a police officer has to respond to.
