
If you have a canine collaborator, please do

## Suspicion

Have you ever seen something suspicious but weren't sure if you should call the police? It happens every day in the VOWS. If you see something that just doesn't look right or even if you're not sure, "Call it in". If it's non-life threatening, call the Fort Worth non-emergency number 817 335-4222. If it could become life threatening, call 911. Your suspicion may not look like much at the moment you see it, but it may end up helping the police with an issue they are addressing the area. In a split second the situation could change and then you would regret not calling. In addition, if you can snap a picture or record video with your phone of a license plate or person, that could be very beneficial.

Please be aware that you should not call an (NPO) neighborhood police officer for an immediate emergency. They may not be working or may be addressing an emergency in another area of town. The FWPD do not monitor social media sites. Any communication between neighbors is fine for passing along information, but will not be an outlet for police response.

Crime Watch is neighbors helping neighbors prevent crime. If you are home during the day, you could be a Crime Watch block captain. All it takes is eyes and ears.







### **Woodland Springs Homeowner's Association**

The purpose of a homeowners association (HOA) is to maintain, enhance and protect the common areas and interests of the subdivision or neighborhood. Individual homeowners, as members of the association, pay periodic assessments support & utilize neighborhood amenities (pond, pools, parks, tennis courts, etc.). The assessments pay for community expenses such as entrance monuments, landscaping, amenities like clubhouses, tennis courts, or walking trails, insurance for commonly-owned structures and areas, an on-site management company, or any other item delineated in the governing documents or agreed to by the homeowners' association.

Currently, the Advisory Committee, which is comprised of elected residents, is the intermediate group between the residents and the Board of Directors and Centurion American (VOWS developer). This will continue until full development of VOWS is completed. The sub-committees report to the Advisory Committee. All residents are invited to attend Advisory Committee meetings which are normally held the 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm at the Amenity Center on Timberland.
