### **COVENANT CORNER**

#### **STORAGE SHEDS**

Thinking about getting a Storage Shed? There are specific guidelines regarding sheds. You want to make sure you have approval prior to installing it. The plastic tuff sheds are not approved. Typically the only sheds that are approved are wood. The shingles have to match the shingles on your home and the trim needs to be painted to match the trim on your home as well. You also need to include a copy of your survey or detailed drawing showing the exact placement of the shed on your property.

To obtain an Architectural Control Committee form, please visit the HOA website at www. woodlandspringshoa or call the onsite office at 817-741-1719.

Here is what the CC&R's have to say about Accessory Structures and sheds:

5.3.7 Accessory Structures. Without the prior written approval of the ACC, accessory structures – such as dog houses, gazebos, playhouses, trampolines, swimming pools, greenhouses, pergolas, workshops, backyard kitchens, fire pits, and tornado shelters are

prohibited (not allowed) if (1) they exceed the height of a fence, or (2) are visible from a street or common area, or (3) are visible by a person standing on the surface of an adjoining lot. Accessory structures may not be located in front yards or in unfenced portions of side yards facing streets. If an accessory structure is installed in violation of this Section, the ACC reserves the right to determine that the accessory structure is unattractive or inappropriate or otherwise unsuitable for the Property, and may require the owner to screen it or to remove it. Except for children's playhouses, dog houses, greenhouses, gazebos and buildings for storage of lawn maintenance equipment, no building previously constructed elsewhere shall be moved onto any Lot, it being the intention that only

new construction be placed and erected thereon.

5.3.8 Storage Sheds. A detached storage shed (one per residential lot) shall be allowed on the property with the following conditions:

a. Shed shall be no larger than 10' x 8'.

b. Shed shall be no taller than 9'0" as measured from the ground.

c. Shed shall not be visible from the street immediately in front of the lot on which



the shed is located. Additional review and consideration will be given to corner Lots to assess visibility of sheds from the side streets. d. Shed shall be situated behind the wooden privacy fence.

e. Shed shall be painted to match the trim color of the house.

f. Shed shall have a roof shingle similar to the roof shingle on the house.

These conditions are a guide for review by the Architectural Control Committee (ACC). The ACC may grant variance from these conditions or impose additional restriction(s) on a case-by-case basis.

## **GOT TRASH?**

#### Fort Worth Garbage & Recycling APP

The city is encouraging residents to take advantage of the Fort Worth Garbage & Recycling APP that can be downloaded free from GooglePlay or iTunes for Android or Apple devices. Residents will receive reminders before their service days as well as incidents that we're experiencing currently with the delayed bulk collections. You can choose how to receive reminders: text message, email or voice message.

Following these simple guidelines will help the contractors stay on schedule for collection:

• Place bulk items on the curb by 7 a.m. Monday of your assigned week.

• Tree limbs that are greater than four inches in diameter or longer than eight feet are considered bulk.

• If you're putting out other bulk items, such as furniture, they need to be kept separate from the yard debris to allow for proper and timely collection.

## CODE BLUE CONNECTION FWPD 6TH DIVISION

We have long awaited news of the Fort Worth Police Department 6th Patrol Division in North Fort Worth. A new patrol division in our area will bring much needed police presence. On April 19, the city council approved the purchase of 2 tracts of land on the west-side of Old Denton Road, just north of North Tarrant Parkway. The budget for design and construction of the facility is 7.5 million dollars. The city council anticipates the construction to fulfill the needs of our rapidly growing area.

What does this mean for us? Currently, the police have the city divided into 5 Divisions, North, East, South, West and Central (being the downtown area). The land mass of the current North Division will most likely be divided, creating a "Far" North Division. This will extend north to the city limits at the Denton County line, north of Texas Motor Speedway. This new division will bring added police presence and better response times.

In Woodland Springs we are very fortunate to have paid Off Duty Officers and a very active Citizen's on Patrol volunteer Group. This added protection has kept our crime at an all-time low! We can all do our part by keeping our garage doors closed, our cars locked and the possessions out of plain sight.

### Soliciting... NOT IN VOWS!!



Please be aware that it is a crime for solicitation to occur in the City of Fort Worth (without a permit). ## New Horseshoe Pits In Vows



The new horseshoe pit is located at the beach area of Pond #2 – Near Hickory

VOWS has one set of Horseshoes that are available for "rental" at the HOA office on Timberland. There is no charge to use the horseshoes, but you must leave your contact information and a refundable deposit \$50 (check or cash – you will receive it back upon the return of the horseshoes). Please return the horseshoes within 24 hours. (48 hours if the office is closed) to have your deposit returned.

#### HOW TO PLAY HORSESHOES

The game is to be played with two to four players, either player-versus-player or pairversus-pair.

Each player throws -- called "pitching" in the game -- a horseshoe, trying to catch the shoe on a stake in the ground, or at the least land the shoe within 6 inches of the stake.



Games are made up of innings and there are 2 pitches per player or team per inning. The first player or pair to score 40 points wins the game.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### What is the difference between a Payment Plan and a Direct Debit Plan?

Payment Plan - If you are behind on your assessment payment and need a little more time to pay you can set up a payment plan to assist you in becoming current on your account. There is a \$25 setup fee charged for this option. Please call the Customer Care Line at 877-378-2388 for more information and to assist you in setting up this plan.

Direct Debit Plan – In a direct debit plan you will have monthly payments deducted from your bank account that will accrue towards your next upcoming assessment – please go online to www.paylease.com or call Customer Care at 877-378-2388.

#### Important Information about the Direct Debit Plan

The Direct Debit plan only works if you are current on your assessments and you start the plan in January or July. Starting the plan on any other month will not accrue enough money to cover your next assessment due date and will result in late fees, interest and additional notice fees.

\*\*\*Starting the Direct Debit plan in January or February will ensure you have enough money in your account to cover the upcoming July assessment.

\*\*\*Starting the Direct Debit plan in July or August will ensure you have enough money in your account to cover the upcoming January assessment.

Assessments are \$245 semi-annually (January 1st & July 1st.) To set up a monthly direct debit you will need to have \$40.84 scheduled to be deducted from your account every month. You will have accumulated \$245.04 in your VOWS Account and your assessment will be PAID IN FULL & ON TIME!

## Resident Speaker Guidelines

Plan your presentation to last no more than 5 minutes. If you feel it will require more time, make sure this is indicated on the Resident Speaker Card, as well as making the office aware when you schedule your presentation date. Please indicate how long you feel you will need.

Please provide handouts at the meeting with as much detail as possible.

Please do not expect an answer or response the evening of the presentation. The topic you address will be placed on the agenda for the next AC meeting.

At the discretion of the AC Chairperson, if your topic is considered an urgent matter requiring an AC decision (same evening) due to severity or a deadline, it will be placed on that night's agenda under New Business.

- During your presentation committee members may ask the AC Chairperson for permission to address the speaker.
- At the end of the presentation, if you are a VOWS resident, you are encouraged to stay for the rest of the meeting. It is the desire of the Advisory Committee that all homeowners participate in these meetings by way of attendance.
- A follow up notification will be sent to you when a decision is made.

## **VOWS Assessment Collections Update**



As some of you may be aware, when you are late paying your dues, you can be levied with late fees, collection fees and interest. Until recently, if the account became delinquent by \$1,000.00 or more, your account could be sent to the attorneys and a lien filed against your home. However, in order to lower if not eliminate the unpaid assessments, the amount triggering filing of a lien has now dropped to \$500.00. Liens, if the assessments owed continue to accrue, can lead to foreclosures and you could lose your home.

During those challenging periods it is often tempting to avoid meeting certain financial obligations in order to meet others. However, when deciding which bills to "juggle" and which to pay remember that your semi-annual association dues are just as important as your mortgage payment. If you don't pay your mortgage, you will eventually lose your home. Likewise, if you don't pay your semi-annual assessment, the association has the right to foreclose on your property and sell it.

More importantly however, is that should you let your assessment become delinquent, in order to bring your account current, you will have to pay more than the original monthly assessment amount. Late fees, interest charges and if applicable various administrative and legal fees must also be paid. The bottom line: Don't juggle your assessment payment. Pay on time and avoid paying more (and possibly losing more!) in the long run.

Remember, your next assessment is due July 1st. Please be timely in payment of your assessments.
