

Also, only one sign is permitted, must be on the premises and can be no larger than 2 square feet in area. NOTE: You have to get a permit from the City of Fort Worth. Here's the link: http://www.fortworthgov.org/forms. Please submit your request at least 72 hours (3 days) prior to your planned sale date. If your request is submitted after 3 PM on Friday you will not receive your permit until the following Monday.

Landscape & Grounds Committee News

Whew! As the dog days of summer thankfully come to a close we can look back at a summer that was HOT but luckily not as hot and harmful to our landscaping as the summer of 2011. The spring rains and occasional summer gully-washer pulled us through, leaving most of the VOWS' new tree installations and color bed materials intact. As the season and our lazy gaze now turns to fall there are some new and exciting color installations in the works that I'm sure you'll want to know about. New varieties of flowers will be installed in the color beds to enhance their "Pop". After experimenting with perennials in early summer it was "pop"-ular opinion that led to our re-planting of more vibrant annuals in the front portions of the village beds. We've decided we will continue with this approach, and then some, for the fall/winter installations! this month, groupings of differing

color knock-out roses are being installed on each of the medians along Timberland near the stone pier clusters. These will add intermittent patches of bright color to the medians for the enjoyment of our west side travelers - do keep your eyes on the road though please. The application for more parkway and median trees to be installed this winter is being generated to continue the LGC's mission to live up to the "Woodland" portion of our namesake. The goal in mind...that this will lead to the eventual "shading" of our entire community - looking forward to that.

Dust...? What dust? You know ... that metamorphosis of Alta Vista into North Beach. Thankfully, plans are being made by your LGC to incorporate this new thoroughfare of green shade, creating an inviting boulevard that will blend seamlessly with our Villages of

Woodland Springs' parkways, starting with entry monuments (similar to those at our other community entrances), enhanced with seasonal color beds, inclusion of median trees, and crepe myrtle beds to match. Soon you will not be able to tell the difference between the new North Beach and the rest of the VOWS' parkways (keep your fingers crossed). It should be a very inviting commute through there. Big thanks to the City of Fort Worth for including the initial infrastructure and tree plantings in THEIR budget.

With Fall comes the budget and planning process for next year. We will continue the landscape and park area improvement projects for 2013 and focus on developing green spaces along the western portion of VOWS. The long term vision for all of VOWS is to have many green enclaves of varying sizes and shapes for all residents

to enjoy. Picture paved, meandering, shaded sidewalks that wind past cooling water features, to grassy or sandy open spaces for playing games. I'm confident we can meet our communities' need for useful and enjoyable green areas in the coming years. With some thoughtful planning, hard work and creative approaches to our landscape challenges, all of this is possible.

Woodland Springs Homeowner's Association

The purpose of a homeowners association (HOA) is to maintain, enhance and protect the common areas and interests of the subdivision or neighborhood. Individual homeowners, as members of the association, pay periodic assessments support & utilize neighborhood amenities (pond, pools, parks, tennis courts, etc.). The assessments pay for community expenses such as entrance monuments, landscaping, amenities like clubhouses, tennis courts, or walking trails, insurance for commonly-owned structures and areas, an on-site management company, or any other item delineated in the governing documents or agreed to by the homeowners' association.

Currently, the Advisory Committee, which is comprised of elected residents, is the intermediate group between the residents and the Board of Directors and Centurion American (VOWS developer). This will continue until full development of VOWS is completed. The sub-committees report to the Advisory Committee. All residents are invited to attend Advisory Committee meetings which are normally held the 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm at the Amenity Center on Timberland. The September 2012 meeting of the Advisory Committee will be on September 25.
