

COVENANT'S CORNER

STORAGE SHEDS GET ACC APPROVAL BEFORE YOU SHOP FOR A STORAGE SHED

You are welcome to have a storage shed in your back yard. There are a few guidelines on sheds that you will need to follow.

In 5.3.8 of the DCC&R's it states:

- 5.3.8 Storage Sheds. Detached storage sheds shall be allowed on the property with the following conditions:
- a. Shed shall be no larger than 10' x 8'.
- b. Shed shall be no taller than 9'0" as measured from the ground.
- c. Shed shall not be visible from the street immediately in front of the lot on which the shed is located. Additional review and consideration will be given to corner Lots to assess visibility of sheds from the side streets.
- d. Shed shall be situated behind the wooden privacy fence.
- e. Shed shall be painted to match the trim color of the house.
- f. Shed shall have a roof shingle similar to the roof shingle on the house.

These conditions are a guide for review by the Architectural Control Committee (ACC). The ACC may grant variance from these conditions or impose additional restriction(s) on a case-by-case basis.



Snake Control Recommendations:

Improper use of mothballs to repel snakes:

Mothballs are commonly thought to repel snakes, but they are not intended to be used this way and have little effect on snakes. Mothballs are nearly 100% active ingredient, and the active ingredient may be either naphthalene or paradichlorobenzene. Each active ingredient can cause different health effects if the exposure is high enough. Mothballs slowly turn from solids to toxic vapor. When you smell mothballs, you are inhaling the insecticide. Mothballs can also be dangerous if they are chewed or eaten. Children, pets and wildlife may mistake them for food or candy and eat them. One mothball can cause serious harm if eaten by a small child.

Snake control recommendations:

Chemical snake repellents are available, but they can pose risks to people, pets, or the environment if they are not used properly. Always be sure to read and follow all label directions if you decide to use one of these products.

Only use repellents that specifically state on the label that they are snake repellents, and use them only according to the label instructions.

Snakes enter areas inhabited by people in search of food and shelter. The easiest thing you can do is make your home and yard less appealing to them.

Prevent snake problems by removing their food sources like rodents. Don't leave pet food out and store animal feed in tight containers.

Make sure door sweeps and window screens fit tightly. Cover vents and drains that lead into your home with galvanized screening.

Snakes also find shelter under scrap metal, wood piles, trash, and other debris. Keep your yard area free of possible hiding places, including tall grass and weeds which can attract prey for snakes.

If you have a snake in the house, there are mechanical traps and glue traps that can be used to capture it. For assistance identifying or removing a snake, try calling your local cooperative extension office, animal control officer (look in the local telephone book), or state wildlife agency.


Waste Handling Procedures

- Leave chemicals in original, labeled container or label containers clearly.
- Place leaking containers in a second container of like material (ex. Corrosives in glass, flammables in metal).
- Place items securely in the trunk of the car or bed of pickup.
 Then just drive through. Remain in your vehicle and allow staff to unload waste.




