## DOGGIES WILL DOO

Be a good neighbor and be sure you are picking up behind your furry friends. We have received complaints recently of people not picking up behind their dogs. When visiting public spaces around VOWS please always watch your animal and make sure to bring

baggies when you leave the house to pick up behind your pets. There are several Doggie Waste Stations throughout VOWS. You will find baggies there and can dispose of pet waste at these stations as well. If you notice that any of the Pet Waste Stations are out of baggies or need emptying, please notify the on-site office.

We have also received complaints from owners who back up to the green spaces. These owners have wrought iron fencing. Some owners state that they have found dog feces in their back yards and they don't own a dog. The fence slats are far enough apart for a small dog to gain entrance to the back yards of these homes. Please be mindful when you are out with your pet and don't allow them to enter into another residents yard.

- Put a Leash on your Dog Please remember that there is a Leash Law in the City of Ft.
  Worth. When a dog is being walked or with its owner off its property, the dog must be on a
  leash and accompanied by the owner at all times. If the dog is without a leash or not accompanied by the owner, it is considered unrestrained and is in violation of the City of Ft. Worth restraint ordinance.
- A cat must remain within the boundaries of its owner's property.
- Thank you for being a responsible pet owner.



### HIRING A TREE PRUNING CONTRACTOR



Finding a good residential tree pruning company can often be a chore. There are a lot of companies to choose from, but how can you know which ones really deliver quality tree work?

In most cases, the quality of the pruning cut says a lot about the quality of the overall pruning job. Tree care companies that have trained their climbers to consistently perform proper pruning cuts have also usually trained their climbers in the other vital aspects of tree pruning.

There are three primary final cuts that can be made when removing a branch from a tree: A stub-cut leaves a branch stub that will result in a cavity as the exposed wood decays. It will also take a long time for the tree to callusover the wound.

A flush-cut cuts too deeply into the trunk or parent stem, which results in a larger wound than needed, longer time before wound closure, and increased decay within the tree.

A collar-cut, as shown in the drawing, angles upward from just outside the branch collar to just outside the top of the branch-bark-ridge. Collar cuts tend to heal quickly and result in less internal decay than flush cuts.

So, when looking for a residential tree prun-

ing company, seek a company with staff that is certified by the International Society of Arboriculture. Also, look for a company that is fully insured – with both workers comp and liability insurance. TCIA (Tree Care Industry Association) accreditation is a plus. Lastly, ask for references that provide examples of the company's pruning work – and then drive by one or two sites and check-out their pruning cuts.

The cuts should be collar-cuts, and the trees should look natural and not over-pruned. Good pruning companies mainly use hand saws in trees – they rarely pull out chainsaws except to remove large branches.

There are an amazing number of companies around the DFW area that are providing poor quality pruning, so don't rely on the courte-ousness and clean-cut appearance of the sales staff or on the impressiveness of the yellow pages ad. Also, don't assume that ISA certification automatically means quality work. Check out the pruning cuts!!!

## MOSQUITO REPELLENT ALTERNATIVES

Summer is here and mosquitoes will soon return in force. Hopefully, you've already taken care of the low lying places in your yard that collect water, but you may not know about several plants that have been known to keep mosquitoes away. Plant them now and perhaps early mornings and evenings on your patio will be much more enjoyable.


Rosemary is an inexpensive and attractive way to repel mosquitoes. This hardy herb likes hot, dry weather which is perfect for north Texas. Simply take a few leaves, crush them in your hand and gently rub the oil essence on your skin (choose a small area to check for allergies). You will smell pleasing to all except the pesky mosquito. Having fresh rosemary growing is a delicious herb to use when preparing many recipes.

Another mosquito repelling plant is ordinary catnip. Several websites indicate that catnip is ten times more effective than DEET. Catnip is a perennial and is easily grown from seeds. You need to crush the leaves of catnip and apply to your skin the same as rosemary. Felines may find you intoxicating yet mosquitoes should not. And did you know, fresh catnip leaves make a soothing herb tea?

The popular garden herb basil has been used as an insect repellent either as a bouquet of stems arranged in a jar of water or as a potted plant. This plant has a penetrating aroma and is very flavorful in a wide range of recipes from Italian to Thai.

Does it seem that mosquitoes are more attracted to some people? An article on the Wilderness College website stated, 'Many outdoors-people have noticed that mosquitoes have a greater attraction to people that have been eating processed, sugary foods, and less attracted to people eating more of a natural diet such as whole grains, fruits, and vegetables. The processed food diet may make your odor and blood chemistry more attractive to mosquitoes. You can choose to eat less processed foods and sugars during the mosquito season. Additionally, diets high in garlic and onions have been noted to help reduce the attraction of mosquitoes.'

Try eating a healthy diet and growing a garden of mosquito repelling plants to combat those irritating and many times harmful insects that plague north Texas.



One such place is Paws in the City. Paws in the City, a no-kill organization, is committed to ending the overpopulation, abuse, and neglect of Dallas area dogs and cats.
